While working among old books and documents, much of her workday is spent planning ways to make more of the Missouri Historical Society's collection searchable via the internet or speaking to groups about the library and its collections. Her research interests include historic maps, immigration, North America in the late 1700s, and the history of etiquette and food.



Dennis Northcott is a native St. Louisan who has been on the staff of the Missouri Historical Society Library and Research Center since 1989. He has compiled numerous guides to the society's manuscript collections, including an inventory of the extensive Civil War holdings. He is the creator of the Genealogy and Local History Index, an ever-growing index that provides access to genealogical sources in the library and archives. He frequently gives presentations on genealogy, house history, and other topics.
